



## Bruce Walter Wahl

October 20, 1948 - October 9, 2023

Bruce Walter Wahl died peacefully surrounded by his children on October 9, 2023.

Bruce is survived by his two children, Michael of Boston, MA; and Catherine (Christopher Bove) of Baltimore, MD; his cherished “chickie”, his granddaughter, Sylvia Bove; his brother Glen (Patricia) of Beavercreek, OH; beloved nieces and nephews, and many friends. He is preceded in death by his wife, Janyce Jess.

Bruce was born on October 20, 1948 in Chicago, IL to Sylvester and Irene (Schultz) Wlozczewski. He married his high school sweetheart, Janyce, in 1969 at Saint Patrick’s Church on Chicago’s South Side. During the Vietnam Conflict, he volunteered to serve his country in the US Navy on the flight deck of the US Oriskany. His lengthy commercial banking career brought him to the East Coast in 1977.
