Charles Alan Coleman, age 68, passed away at home, on July 25, 2018, in Columbia, MA. He was born on February 1, 1950, in Baltimore, MD. He graduated from Sparrows Point High School, in Edgemere, MD, in 1968, where he was named a National Merit Scholar for scoring so highly on his SATs. He graduated from Virginia Polytechnic Institute (VPI), in Blacksburg, VA, in 1973, with a degree in Computer Science. After college, he went to work for Bendix Corporation (now Allied Signal), a contractor for Goddard Spaceflight Center in Greenbelt, MD. He retired from Allied Signal in 2013. Alan, as he was known by his family (Charles to his friends and co-workers), was a beloved son, brother, and uncle.
