Cora Virginia Graham, 87, of Owings Mills, MD, passed away on Wednesday, March 25, 2020 after a sudden and brief illness. She was the fourth child born to parents Samuel Webster Hutchins and Flora Indiana Hutchins (Watts), on August 29, 1932.

Cora was born and lived her early life in Calvert County, MD where she grew up on a farm and learned to tend the land. She received her education in the Calvert County Public School system. She enjoyed reading and learning and passed on this love for education to her five children.

Cora met Briscoe Graham in 1954. They were married on January 22, 1955 in Calvert County, MD. A few years later, they relocated to Baltimore, MD. From this union, five children were born: Bridget, Corinthian, Briscoe Jr., Paulette, and Victoria.

Cora worked at Johns Hopkins Hospital for many years as a custodial worker before leaving in 1975 after the birth of her youngest child, Victoria. She then worked as a housekeeper for various families before retiring in 2004. After retirement she enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren.

Cora was an avid church goer who attended Rehoboth Church of God in Christ Jesus Apostolic in Baltimore, MD and read the Lord's Prayer to her children each night at bedtime. She was preceded in death by her siblings: James Hutchins, Flora Conway, Maggie Reynolds, Eliza Butler, and Gladys Jackson.

Cora is survived by Briscoe M. Graham, Sr., her husband of 65 years. Her five

children, Bridget, Corinthian, Briscoe, Paulette, and Victoria. Her two sons in law, Adrika and Melvin, Daughter in law Carol, ten grandchildren: Desmond, Di'Anna, Kristina, Kameron, Kierston, Damien, Nylah, Kayla, Bryce, and Maya, and a host of nieces and nephews.
