Dan was a wonderful father and good provider and dearly loved all of his girls. Dan was very accomplished at his profession in the mechanical field of HVAC, specializing in refrigeration. He became known in the business for figuring out problems when many others could not. Dan loved history and politics; he even campaigned door-to-door for our current president! He loved music, especially the band, Alice in Chains, as

you may have noticed, his daughter Dakota's middle name is Layne, he was very proud of that contribution! Dan loved Baltimore sports and was a true fan of the Orioles, Ravens and the Terps!
