Daniel “Danny” Wood, aged 70, passed peacefully in his sleep the evening of May 11 under the care of Heavenly Home and Hospice in Baltimore, Maryland.

Danny was born in Macon, GA to parents James and Elizabeth Wood and grew up there alongside his siblings Bucky, Jamie, Nancy, and Monty. In high school, he was an avid athlete and found a connection in sports with his future wife, Karen. The two attended Georgia College in Milledgeville, where he earned a degree in psychology, and married shortly thereafter. Their early years saw several moves, including to Augusta, GA, where their first child, Jennifer, was born, and the small family eventually settled in Florida, where Danny lived longest. Another daughter, Stephanie, and a son, Matthew, were both born in Florida, and the family enjoyed spending time at the beaches together.

Throughout his life, Danny worked mostly in retail sales for home improvement stores and enjoyed listening to oldies, country, and many comedians, particularly the Three Stooges. He was involved in scouting with his son and spoke often of wanting to hike the Appalachian Trail, even after his failing health and diabetes complications led to amputations.

Danny is survived by his sisters, Jamie and Monty; his ex-wife, Karen; his

children, Jennifer, Stephanie, and Matthew along with Matthew's wife, Heather; and his three grandchildren, Matthew Junior, Hunter, and Hadlee. His passing reunites him with his parents, brother, Bucky, and sister Nancy in their eternal peace.
