Born in Cumberland, Maryland, on December 26th, 1955, Dennis French White was the second son of Vernie (“Boots”) and French (“June”) White. In his youth, Denny enjoyed crabbing and swimming in the creeks of Magothy River, as well as keeping up on the Orioles—a lifelong passion,

Denny worked a number of jobs throughout his life—most notably as a particularly affable automotive parts counter person—living in California and Florida before ultimately settling back to Maryland.

When he was older, Denny could often be found at the Severna Park American Legion. Though he generally kept to himself, he was always willing to discuss the Ravens and the O’s.

Denny wasn’t a materialistic man, he liked to keep things simple. He loved listening to music, especially rock ’n roll. The words most commonly used when describing him are generous, kind, bighearted, and funny. And even after the diabetes and cancer made him unable to walk or fully take care of himself, he always had a joke. He never once complained or became angry. His spirit was positivity. He just wanted to have a good time.

In his final days, Denny took comfort in his favorites shows—old Westerns, mostly, but also The Price is Right, M*A*S*H* and The Three Stooges. And at

any hour of the day he could be heard calling to his brother: “Ran’? What time Orioles playing?”

Dennis White passed away in his childhood home with his older brother, Randy (“Ran”), and his nephew looking over him. He is survived by Randy and two younger siblings, Rick and Joseph White.
