



Don George Kadron

August 20, 1939 - January 18, 2023

On January 18, 2023, Don George Kadron, beloved husband, brother-in-law and uncle died after a lengthy illness. He was 83. The youngest child of the late Frieda Marie Kuhlow Kadron and John C. Kadron, he was born August 20, 1939 in Baltimore. Raised in the family home on Manchester Avenue, Don attended Baltimore Polytechnic Institute and went on to earn an Electrical Engineering degree at Johns Hopkins University.

Don is survived by his loving wife, Vera, his sister-in-law, Josie Kadron and many nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his parents, and siblings, Audrey R. Townshend, John C. Kadron, Carl S. Kadron, and Stanley F. Kadron. Don married Vera Marian Davis October 3, 1971 and they moved to their beloved Severn River home in 1972. Together, Don and Vera enjoyed cycling, sailing, kayaking, photography, travel, theater and the musical arts. He was an accomplished guitarist and could play all types of guitars, being particularly adept with a 12 string acoustic. His ability to read sheet music and play any music was a rare talent. Don was also a HAM radio enthusiast and maintained his license W3WTU for many years.

Don retired from an exemplary career at Westinghouse Electric as a lead engineer on numerous key projects. His name is associated with several high

tech patents and development of many military and NASA related devices.

Don was active and dedicated for many years at St. Bernadette's and Church of the Holy Apostles where he was a member of the music ministries. This was one of his greatest joys along with sharing music with others.

Don and Vera rarely missed a family event, especially involving nieces and nephews. Don could be counted on for help with science projects and math tutoring. He was able to make a learning experience fun. His nieces and nephews always looked forward to visiting him and being serenaded with guitar and song. They recall learning "Puff the Magic Dragon" at an early age.
