Douglas Edward Shepley, 83, of Waynesboro, PA passed away peacefully Monday, November 10, 2025 at Doey's House.

In his spare time, Doug enjoyed watching Westerns, action movies, and Gold Rush. He enjoyed playing Skip-Bo and going out to eat with his son Mike. Doug also enjoyed playing cards with friends, camping, crabbing, boating and fishing.
