



## Elizabeth Catherine Allred

July 26, 1926 - March 21, 2025

Elizabeth (Betty) Catherine Allred (nee Schwalier), 22-year resident of Heritage Harbour in Annapolis, MD and former 37-year resident of Severna Park, MD died on March 21, 2025 from natural causes, at the Sheridan Assisted Living Facility. Betty was born July 26, 1926 in Annapolis, Maryland and grew up on a dairy farm in the St. Margaret's area east of Annapolis. Betty attended St. Mary's Catholic Elementary school in Annapolis through the 8th grade and Annapolis High school, graduating in 1944. Post high school, Betty attended secretarial school and worked as a Secretary at the Navel Academy for several years before she was offered an opportunity to transfer to the Army Language School in Monterey, California where she met and married her husband Anthon Venioy Allred, Sr. After that she lived as an Army wife in a number of locations assigned to her husband in the US and for three years, abroad in Germany. They finally settled in Severna Park, Maryland, where she returned to work at the U.S. Navel Academy as a Secretary in the Superintendents office. Betty loved gardening, crafts, and took much pleasure from her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Predeceased by her husband of 55 years, Anthon Venioy Allred, Sr. Betty is survived by her three children, Tony Allred Jr. and Nancy Allred-Davis (Will) of Pasadena, Maryland and Heidi Reilley (Michael) of Alloway, New Jersey and four grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. Cremation is to follow brain donation to Parkinson's Disease and Research Center, Johns Hopkins
