Harvey Earl Leach was born in 1950 in Corpus Christie, Texas to Helen Coulter Leach and Jack Leach. He graduated from Bloomington High School in Bloomington, Texas where he lettered in football, baseball and track. He was drafted by Houston Astros farm club and played one year with them. He joined the Navy and became a hospital corpsman. He served his first duty station at Naval Hospital US Naval Academy. He served with the United States Marines at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina and served as a recruiter in New Jersey. From there, he attended preventive medicine school in San Francisco. When he completed school, he was assigned to the USS Constellation CV-64 at Naval Air Station, Coronado, California. He continued his Naval career stationed at Naval Submarine Base Bangor, Washington; US Naval Base Pearl Harbor, Hawaii where he had the opportunity to work with the National Science Foundation at McMurdo Station, Antarctica. He retired as a Chief Hospital Corpsman from Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center, Twentynine Palms, California, after serving twenty-five years in the US Navy. Mr. Leach was a devoted and loving husband, married to Kristin Humphries Leach for thirty-eight years and a dedicated and proud father helping to raise a daughter, Brandyn, and two sons, Matthew and Michael. He also delighted in being the father-in-law of Marissa and Amanda. He enjoyed every exciting, blessed moment as the lucky grandfather to TJ, Brady, Harper, and Hayley and great-granddaughter, Paisley. Mr. Leach passed peacefully at his home.
