



## Henry Stoehr

June 7, 1936 - June 13, 2025

Henry Stoehr, 89, a longtime resident of Davidsonville, MD, passed away on June 13, 2025, after a brief illness.

Born on June 7, 1936, in Washington, DC, Henry was the son of Henry William “Chris” and Martha Lee “Pat” Stoehr and was raised in Montgomery County, MD. He proudly served in the U.S. Navy from 1956 to 1959 and later retired from PEPCO after 33 years of dedicated service.
