



Jane Ellen Carbone

August 15, 1963 - April 20, 2023

It is with deepest sorrow that we announce the passing of Jane Ellen Carbone of Glen Burnie, MD on Thursday April 20th, 2023. She was 59 years old. Jane was born on August 15th, 1963 in Manhattan, NY; she was the daughter of the late Mary (Pryor) Moynihan and William Woodruff.

A New York native, Jane grew up alongside her cousins, Aunt, Uncle and grandparents in White Plains, N.Y before moving between Dobbs Ferry, Irvington and Verplanck. A modern-day Renaissance woman, she was a model at the age of 5, an award-winning pianist at the age of 8, then graduated from Irvington high school at the age of 15 before beginning her collegiate career. She initially attended Westchester Community College, transferring from there to SUNY Stony Brook and then to NYU where she studied pharmacology with a special interest in oncology after losing two of her aunts to cancer. She was a former junior marketing analyst at McCall Pattern company as well as a paralegal at Debevoise and Plimpton before leaving her career to be a full time mother of 4 children with her late husband Michael Sarno. She went on to marry her best friend and love of her life, Ralph Carbone and were happily together for the past 29 years.

She dedicated her life to her children, becoming involved in Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Little League, AYSO, as well as being the most vocal parent in the stands during football, softball, and basketball games. She would move mountains to make sure her children had everything they would ever need even in the hardest times. She was a former American Red Cross member, assisting in disaster relief programs and charity work through the organization. Her motherly nature extended past her own children, consistently opening her door to people in need and providing them a safe, nurturing environment.

Jane will be remembered for her selfless generosity, vast knowledge, and undeniable stubbornness. She had an infectious laugh and she brought a chaotic, but lively energy into every room she entered. She enjoyed simple pleasures in life, such as cooking, attending concerts, music festivals, connecting with people she loved on Facebook and spending time with all of her family, especially her grandchildren.

Jane is survived by her husband Ralph Carbone and children, Michael Sarno and his wife Emily, Kaitlyn Sarno, Kristen Sarno Drobysh and her husband Joseph, and Christopher Sarno; grandchildren Andrew Stickle, Jordan Stickle, Anthony Sarno, Adelyn Sarno, Jackson Sarno, Kaia Sarno, Talia Sarno and Landon Drobysh; sister, Lizbeth Meszaros and brother-in-law Steven Meszaros and brother John Moynihan. Also surviving are her nephews Kevin Meszaros and Brian Meszaros along with countless loving cousins, aunts and uncles. In addition to her parents, grandparents and ex-husband, Jane was predeceased by her step father John "Jack" Moynihan, her Aunt that she was named after Jane Morris and Uncle Raymond Morris along with Vinny Camperlengo.
