Jesse Erdman Capel, 58, passed unexpectedly on November 23rd 2024. He is survived by his wife Tracy, his daughter Shelby, sisters Shirley Compton of South Carolina, Betty Hardman of Grasonville Maryland, brothers James Capel of Grasonville Maryland and brother John Capel of Centerville and many nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his parents James and Marie Capel, his sister's Barbara Ann and Virginia Ruth and his brother Joseph Capel.
