



## Lewis John "Lew" Frith

Lewis John "Lew" Frith passed away on October 8, 2025 at Sinai Hospital in Baltimore. Born December 3, 1959, in Brooklyn, New York to the late Edwin L. and Ann F. (nee Glaab) Frith, Lew grew up and remained in Timonium, Maryland. He was a 1977 graduate of Dulaney High School, where he played drums (and cowbell) in the school's first marching band.
