Linda Schoenberger, 74, beloved Mother and Grandmother peacefully passed away October 27, 2023. Born February 6, 1949, in Baltimore, she was the Daughter of the late LT Leonard and Elizabeth (Houston) Schoenberger.

She grew up traveling the world, living in Norway, Iran, Switzerland, Uruguay, Chile, and the United Kingdom. She graduated from the Uruguayan American School in 1968. She served in the US Army Reserve from 1978 to 1981, attaining the rank of SGT, before dedicating her life to public service with the federal government. Linda worked at the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and at National Institutes of Health as an Executive Administrative Assistant. Post retirement she worked for GeneDX in Gaithersburg, Maryland, for several years.

Her real devotion was to the family she adored more than anything in this world. Linda is survived by her son Clayton Hodo II (Laurel, Maryland), her daughter Cylda Hodo (Mt. Airy, Maryland); and her grandsons Caleb Hodo and Clayton "Tripp" Hodo III.

Linda had a love for all living things, was never without something in her

signature color purple, and had an infectious laugh that spread happiness everywhere. She will be forever missed by those that knew her, but the memory of her smile and shared adventures will bring warmth with the stories of her that will live on through her friends and family.
