M. Latimer Banner III "Lad", 93 of Pasadena MD, passed away on October 26, 2024 at Hospice of the Chesapeake in Pasadena, MD. Lad was born on September 12, 1931 to M. Latimer Banner Jr. and Ruth Virginia Bull, the oldest of 3 sons. He was preceded in death by his brother, Robert H Banner and survived by David L Banner of Pasadena.

Born at Cheri-Oak-a, his childhood home in Pasadena, he graduated from Towson High School in 1949. Lad served in the Army during the Korean Conflict and upon his return he and his brother Rob owned and operated an Amoco Gas station in West Chester, PA. It was there that he met and married the love of his life, Dot. They raised their 6 children in Frazer, PA before returning to his family home on the Magothy River in 1975 where he worked for Chesapeake and Potomac telephone (Verizon) as a truck mechanic until he retired. He was well known for his quiet demeanor and dry wit as he would sit back and observe rather than participating in most conversations but if he had a strong opinion he would share. He enjoyed taking care of his home and family as well as traveling in their motorhome, sailing, boating and cruises. He was preceded in death by his wife of 63 years, Dorothy O. Banner (Dot) and eldest daughter Judith L. Sain (Butch). He is survived by their children, Linda J. Foss (Kyle), Maurice L. Banner IV (Jennie), Beth A. Sturdevant (Mike), W.
