Surrounded by family, Norman David Williams, “Dave”, a retired US Marshal died on February 13, 2019 after a courageous battle with Pulmonary Fibrosis. At 79 years old Dave is survived by his wife of 49 years, Cathy, and their 2 children; “Jay” (and his spouse Laura and their children Drew and Leah) and “Beth” (and her spouse Kevin and their children Dean and Jameson). Dave was born in Missouri and was raised in California with his three sisters and one brother. Dave joined the army in 1967 and was stationed at Fort Mead as military police. While at Fort Mead, Dave met his beloved wife Cathy. Cathy and Dave married in 1969 and they remained in Maryland to raise their family. Dave received his bachelor’s degree from American University in 1971 and began working for the United States Marshal Service, a job he held with honor. In 1985 Dave received the Robert Forsyth valor award which was one of many proud moments of his career. During his retirement years, Dave worked court security in the Federal Court (in Greenbelt, MD). It was also in his retirement that Dave was able to pursue his many hobbies such as golf, hunting, and fishing. Dave’s real passion was restoring and rebuilding cars. One of his fondest memories was restoring a 1964 ½ Ford Mustang with his son Jay. He continued to restore cars and was in the process of restoring a 1959 Ford Fairlane. Dave also had a passion for the wild-west with a fondness for John Wayne-type heroism and all the glory that comes with it, he was a true cowboy at heart. He worked to instill his love of the wild-west in his grandchildren with stories of bravery and honor. Dave said what he meant and

Dave always did his best and gave his all and he taught his children to do the same. He was a good fellow and will be missed by all.
