



## Paul Eldridge Gale

October 22, 1946 - June 12, 2019

Paul E. Gale Jr., 72 of Chesapeake City Maryland, passed away on June 12, 2019 at home, surrounded by loved ones, after a brave battle with cancer. A Celebration of Life will be held beginning 11:00 on July 13, 2019 at Paul's home in Chesapeake City. The American Legion Post #194 Honor Guard will provide military honors followed by stories and celebration. Paul was born in Clinton North Carolina to Paul E. He was a long time member of the Taylor Creek Hunting Lodge in Dushore, Pennsylvania where he enjoyed hunting and long term friendships with the other members. Paul was an avid boater and fisherman and most enjoyed sharing his love for fishing with others.
