Robert Salvatore Gulino, 70, of Nottingham, MD passed away on Monday, October 13th, 2025, surrounded by his family. 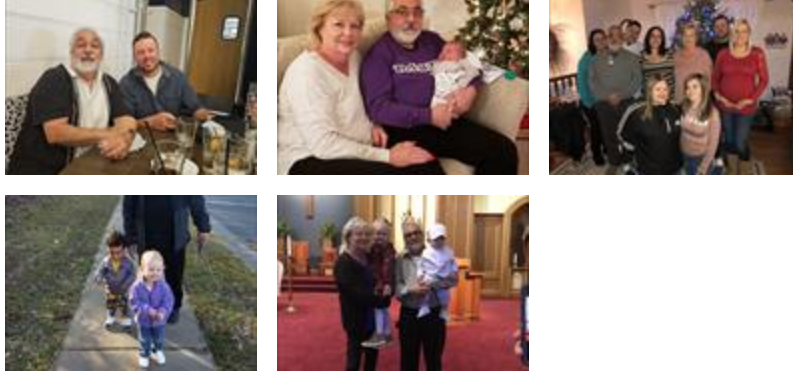

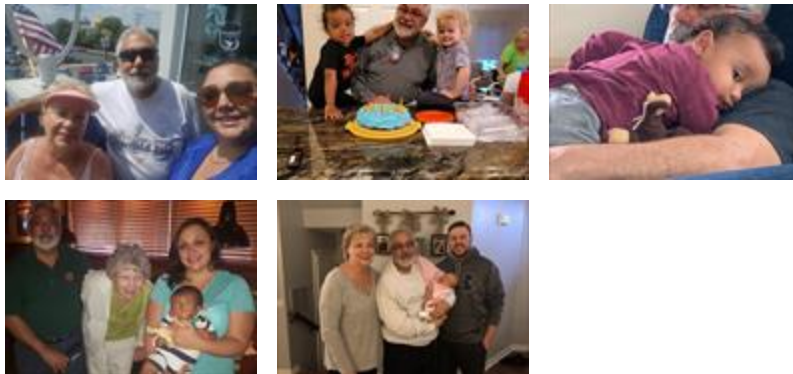
