Robert Dean Rodgers, beloved husband of Jane Crickenberger Rodgers, passed away on March 10, 2021 at Sunrise in Annapolis. He was born on May 24, 1930 and raised in Adrian, Michigan. Upon joining the Navy, he was stationed at Fort Detrick in Frederick, MD, where he met his future wife.

He spent most of his career as a salesman, first selling medical supplies for Will Ross and later selling high-end office furniture for Herman Miller and Steelcase.
