Rodolfo “Rudy” Ignacio Eser, age 63, born 9/16/1957 in Manila, Philippines passed away suddenly on 11/26/2020. He was living in an assisted living facility in Marriottsville, Maryland. Rudy was lovingly known as Boyet to his Filipino relatives.
