Susan Hulse Wood passed away on January 2, 2020, 11 years to the day after the death of her husband James Owen Wood, Sr. Mary Elizabeth Susan Hulse was born on October 19, 1932 in Annapolis, MD, the first of two daughters born to Joshua Booth Hulse and Laura Louise Fifer Hulse. She grew up in Galesville, MD and graduated from Southern High School (Anne Arundel County) in 1950. She attended the University of Maryland School of Nursing, earning her Nursing Degree in 1953.

Sue married James Owen “Woody” in 1951 and gave birth to the first of three children in 1954. They raised their children primarily in Upper Marlboro, MD. They enjoyed camping with their children and later enjoyed visiting their camping trailer, with their beloved dogs, at various campgrounds in the area. Their children and grandchildren often enjoyed visiting them.

Sue had a successful nursing career with the last 30 years at Prince Georges Hospital Center, earning Nurse of the Year from the Maryland Nursing Association in 1997. Sue was very involved in community activities and her church, where she had been a very active member and volunteer for over 40 years. She was the recipient of the Prince George’s County Senior Volunteer of the Year in 2007. She enjoyed duckpin bowling, swimming, exercising and traveling extensively with the Prince George’s Community College Senior group. Her last big trip was to New Zealand and Australia in 2017.

Sue is survived by oldest son, Jimmy, his wife Eva and their daughter Daisy (Arty) and son Dain, and Daisy and Arty’s children, Savannah and Hudson;
