Tereaz Mack Scholze, age 61, made her transition into the light on January 27, 2021. Tereaz was born March 6, 1959 in Baltimore, Maryland to Warren and Daisy Mack. She was raised by Warren and Thelma Mack after Daisy passed away in 1961, when Tereaz was age 2. Tereaz eloped and married Gary Matthew Scholze, the love of her life, on December 1, 1988.

Tereaz graduated from Highland View Academy in 1977 and was accepted into the Washington Adventist Hospital X-ray technician program. She worked as an X-ray tech off and on for 25 years. She paused her employment to raise her son, Austin Matthew Scholze, then decided to pursue a career in the healing arts. She studied continually, always expanding her scope of practice.
