“ Terry and I were best friends in the 50's. I lived at 312 Shipley from 2nd through 6th grades. She and Joey ate supper with us often. Joey and my brothers, Chuck and Bob played together. As kids we formed our own club like the Little Rascals. We also made up our own Mickey Mouse club. We made clothes for our Ginny and Betsy McCall dolls. We watched the circus programs on Saturday morning tv and tried to do all the acrobatics we saw there. I don't remember Terry getting hurt but I fell onto the fence- straddling the fence. We quit trying to walk the fence after that. We had rings and various swings to try and hurt ourselves on instead. There was a vacant field behind the drive-in movie at the end of the street. We took the wagon and dug up the pretty little reddish shrubby plants there which we tried selling door to door. After we had sold about a dozen of them to the neighbors, we found out we were selling poison oak. Patty, lived at the other end of the street near that field, ended up in the hospital for a week after that fiasco. We had roller skates and some of the houses had sidewalks. We'd skate like mad on the sidewalk, hit the grass and run until we hit the next sidewalk. Lots of scraped elbows and knees after our races. We had lots of bicycle races and lots of scraped skin from trying to slide into the curve when going full speed around corners. My dad made a point of pulling the hem of my wedding dress up to show no bandages on my knees for once. We were wild children. Locked outside at times while our mothers were house cleaning. We drank from the hose and ate clean dirt 🐾🏠♂️. We had pogo sticks and hula hoops. We got really good at those. We pulled up strange grasses and weeds and chewed on them. We lost touch a couple of years after Terry married. I still miss her and remember lots of the wild and wooly things we got into. She knew me as Judy Bullock.
