



Wayne Dewey Stettler

Wayne Dewey Stettler passed away peacefully at the age of 91 on August 11th, 2022.

Born on September 12th, 1930, he was the eldest son of the late Ruth (nee Carr) and Wayne Stettler. He was raised in Hershey, Pa. Wayne graduated from Muhlenberg College in Allentown, PA, following in the footsteps of his father. In time, his son David and his granddaughters Amy and Chelsea would also graduate from Muhlenberg. Wayne received his medical degree from Jefferson Medical College in Philadelphia, PA. Wayne lived most of his adult life in Chatham, NJ, raising his family there. He was a beloved pediatrician at the Summit Medical Group in Summit, NJ. Prior to retirement, he also worked for the Warner Lambert Company. In 2011, Wayne and his wife Joan moved to the Shannondell retirement community in Audubon, PA. In 2022, he moved to Millersville, MD to be closer to family. He enjoyed playing billiards and golf and early morning visits to coffee shops. He was known as a great storyteller.

Wayne was predeceased by his loving wife of 61 years Joan; his son David (wife Janice); his sister Elizabeth Almgren; and his brother John Stettler. He is survived by children Jeffrey (wife Lisa) and Kristin (husband Michael Boyle); six grandchildren (Amy, Chelsea, Richard, Charlotte, Trevor and Calla); three

great-grandchildren (Ford, Beatrice and Shelby); and many nieces, nephews, grand-nieces and grand-nephews.
