February 8, 1933 - May 12, 2024

William “Bill” J. Krayzel, owner of Bill Krayzel & Associates, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on May 12, 2024.

A first generation Slovakian American, Bill was born on February 8, 1933 in Searights PA to the late Andrew and Maria Krayzel. The youngest of ten, he was preceded in death by two brothers, seven sisters, his beloved wife of 56 years, Anna Marie Krayzel, and a beloved daughter, Roberta. He is survived by three stepchildren, six grandchildren, five great grandchildren and is the Krayzel Family Patriarch as the incomparable “Uncle Bill” to many nieces, nephews, grand nieces, grand nephews, and one great grandniece who he loved dearly.

A veteran of the Korean War, Bill was a proud United States Marine who listened to the Marine Corps Hymn each morning. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting from the University of Baltimore and worked as an accountant for Baltimore Gas & Electric/Exelon for 26 years. In 1971, he opened Bill Krayzel & Associates, where he prepared taxes for hundreds of families and businesses each year for the last 53 years, including 179 returns in 2023.

Bill loved people, was quick-witted and charming and delighted in bringing a smile to every person he encountered.
